APPLICATION TIMELINE

- **April 13, 2012:** Complete applications due to the Office of Educational Outreach at The Juilliard School.
- **Early May 2012:** Applicants with complete applications notified of scheduled audition time.
- **May 12, 2012:** Auditions at The Juilliard School. Only applicants that have received and confirmed a scheduled audition time will be seen.
- **Late May – June 2012:** Based on performance at audition, select students will be scheduled for parent and student interviews at The Juilliard School.

NOTE: Families invited to an interview who wish to be considered for financial aid must submit an Application for Financial Aid and all required financial documents at their interview. Please refer to MAP's website at www.juilliard.edu/map for more information.

- **July – August 2012:** Applicants notified of admission decisions.
- **September 2012:** 2012-2013 MAP school year begins.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Juilliard School's **Music Advancement Program** (MAP) is a Saturday instrument instruction program for highly talented students **ages eight to fourteen** who reside in **the tri-state area (NY, NJ, CT)**. MAP targets children from backgrounds under-represented in American performing arts. Financial aid is available to families that apply for assistance. The Office of Educational Outreach does not consider an applicant's financial situation when making admissions decisions. Qualified applicants must have **at least two years of experience playing** their instrument and should demonstrate high musical potential. **African-American, Native American, and Latino students** are especially encouraged to apply, as well as **students who play the following instruments:** Viola, Double Bass, Clarinet, Flute, Oboe, Bassoon, Trumpet, Trombone, French Horn, Tuba, Saxophone, Percussion.

Admitted students are placed into one of four levels ranging from intermediate (Level 1) to advanced (Level 4).

MAP STUDENTS ARE...

- Intermediate and advanced students who are committed to rigorous musical study
- Students who wish to strengthen their skills in order to successfully audition for advanced music preparatory programs

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY

- At least two years experience on the instrument*
- Reside in the tri-state area (NY, NJ, CT)
- Age 8-14 at time of audition (entering 3rd-9th grade in fall 2012)
- Demonstrate strong parental support and a desire to pursue serious musical study
- Note: Students who have already applied to the program must wait one year to re-apply

**Applicants auditioning on piano, violin, cello, and guitar must have at least three years experience*

SCHEDULE COMMITMENT

- Saturdays, 9am-3:30pm (exact class schedule varies by level)
- At least 1 hour of practice per day, 7 days a week

LENGTH OF PROGRAM

- 1-4 years, depending on level

COURSES

- Private or semi-private lesson
- Large and small performance ensembles
- Additional courses covering:
 - Technique
 - Music theory
 - Ear training
 - Performance skills
 - Audition preparation

TUITION

- Annual cost per pupil varies by level from \$1,500 to \$4,500.
