About Juilliard Dance

Under the leadership of Alicia Graf Mack, dean and director, Juilliard Dance develops artists of the 21st century trained in ballet, modern, and contemporary dance forms. With the establishment of the dance division in 1951—by then-president William Schuman with the guidance of founding division director Martha Hill—Juilliard became the first major teaching institution to combine equal instruction in both modern and ballet techniques.

In the four-year dance program, which leads to a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree, students learn the great traditions of both past and present. Juilliard dancers enjoy unparalleled opportunities to work with today's leading choreographers and perform both new and existing repertory. In addition to receiving high caliber training and giving performances, dancers learn about the craft of choreography and immerse themselves in other facets of the field. Juilliard, which is located at Lincoln Center in New York City, prepares dancers for all the possibilities that lie ahead.

Juilliard dance alumni include the choreographers and directors Robert Battle, Pina Bausch, Jessica Lang, Lar Lubovitch, Andrea Miller, Ohad Naharin, Bobbi Jene Smith, Paul Taylor, and Sylvia Waters. Juilliard dancers are dancing in companies including Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater, Ballet BC, Ballet Hispánico, Ballett des Saarländisches Staatstheater, Ballets Jazz Montréal, Batsheva Dance Company, Boston Ballet, Gibney Company, GöteborgsOperans Danskompani, Hubbard Street Dance Chicago, Kidd Pivot, L.A. Dance Project, Limón Dance Company, Martha Graham Dance Company, Nederlands Dans Theater, and Rambert as well as in several Broadway productions.

The Juilliard Dance Division, proud recipient of the 2015 Capezio Award, was the first educational institution to receive the honor.

A dedication to those who fought for our freedom and our voice, *Freedom* transcends mere movement, morphing into a profound manifestation of bodily release and spiritual transcendence, encapsulating the very soul of emancipation itself. Within this choreographic work, the dance steps and gestures, originally birthed from my upcoming opus, *Losing My Religion* (2026), have been woven into a tapestry of liberation on the stage. Each movement, a brushstroke of freedom's palette, intertwines past and present, breathing new life into the essence of liberation, as the Juilliard dancers embody the ethereal dance of freedom's embrace, with the goal of leaving audiences spellbound.

About the Artists



Rennie Harris

Arnhold Creative Partner Rennie Harris is a renowned choreographer known for his groundbreaking work in bringing social dances to the concert stage. He is credited with coining the term "street dance theater" and has been instrumental in setting works on ballet-based companies including Ballet Memphis, Colorado Ballet, Pennsylvania Ballet, and Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater. Harris' notable achievements include being the first street dancer commissioned to create an evening-length work for Alvin Ailey American Theater and serving as a resident artist at the Alvin Ailey School. Harris has received three Bessie Awards and was recently nominated for three more for the remounting of Rome & Jewels in 2023. He has received five Black Theater Alvin Ailey Awards, the Herb Alpert Award, and a Lawrence Olivier Award nomination in the U.K. He was voted one of the most influential people in the last 100 years of Philadelphia's history and has been compared to influential figures Basquiat, Alvin Ailey, and Bob Fosse. Harris has received several fellowships, including the Guggenheim Fellowship, PEW Fellowship, and USA Artist of the Year Fellowship. He has also been honored with lifetime achievement awards by Dance Magazine and the Palm Desert Dance Festival. He's received honorary doctorates from Bates College and Columbia College Chicago. Harris has also served as a cultural ambassador for the U.S. Embassy Tour and was invited to the White House by the Clinton administration to recognize African American artists making a difference in the world. Harris has performed for dignitaries including the Queen of England and the princesses of Monaco. His was chosen as one of four U.S. companies to serve as a hip-hop cultural ambassador for President Obama's Dance Motion USA and it has toured countries including Israel, Jordan, Egypt, Japan, China, Gambia, and Kazakstan. Harris has also been awarded the Doris Duke Artist Award, Andrew W. Mellon Grant for building a legacy of street dance, Hermitage Greenfield Award, and Samuel H. Scripps American Dance Festival Award. Harris is widely recognized as a leading ambassador and influential figure in the world of hip-hop.

Angel D. Anderson

Angel D. Anderson is a performing artist, scholar, and educator from the south suburbs of Chicago. Encompassing various dance forms rooted in Africanist traditions, her movement archive includes street and club dance forms, modern and contemporary sensibilities, neotraditional African dances, and traditional West African dances. Anderson is an alum of the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, where she earned her BFA in dance and BS in psychology. Alongside performing as a core member in Rennie Harris Puremovement, she has assisted Harris in *Dear Frankie*, set on Hubbard Street Dance Chicago and *In Good Company*, set on Dayton Contemporary Dance Company. Committed to acquiring knowledge on the lineages of Black American dance forms, Anderson studies at Rennie Harris University and Ecole Des Sables via the Training Diaspora Africa program. Her focus on expanding her knowledge and developing her teaching pedagogy reflects a dedication to passing on African American traditions to future generations.



Ms Vee

A multifaceted dancer, performer, choreographer, and teacher specializing in hip-hop and street dance, Vancouver native Ms Vee has made a name for herself in the New York City dance scene since 2003. Vee is a company member of Ephrat Asherie Dance, which has been presented at Jacob's Pillow Dance Festival, the Joyce Fall for Dance, and Sadler's Wells Breaking Convention. Her choreographic work can be seen in the viral video "Hideaway" by Kiesza, in which she is a featured dancer and co-choreographer. "Hideaway" has amassed more than one billion views and was nominated for the MTV video music award for best choreography and won the Juno Award for best video. Her many dance and choreography credits include (TV) VH1 Dear Mama Special, The Detour, The Late Show With David Letterman, The Ellen Show, Jimmy Kimmel Live, Live With Kelly and Michael, Macy's Thanksgiving Parade, Much Music Video Awards, and MTV European Music Awards; (film) Step Up 3D, College Road Trip, and Deep Rising; (Off Broadway) Groovaloo: Freestyle and Rennie Harris' Legends of Hip Hop; and (festivals) Lincoln Center Out of Doors, San Francisco Hip Hop Festival, Festival Encore, and Ladies of Hip Hop. With a bachelor's in kinesiology and education (University of British Columbia), Vee is in high demand as a teacher and dance educator. Her classes are fun, challenging, and informative. She has been on the faculty of New York's Broadway Dance Center since 2004. In 2013, she joined Pace University's commercial dance BFA program, where she is a professor of hip-hop, and, in 2017, she became the first person to teach hip-hop at Juilliard. Vee tours across the U.S. and performs and teaches master classes and workshops internationally.



About the Designers

Leslie Lura-Smith (Lighting Design)

Leslie Lura-Smith is a New York City-based lighting designer working primarily in theater and dance. Past Juilliard productions include May Dance 2022 and 2023, Martha Graham's *Deep Song*, and June Dance 2021. She teaches the stagecraft class to the third-year dancers, advising them on their lighting designs for Choreographers and Composers as well as Senior Production. She also regularly designs with Pan Asian Repertory Theatre, Post Theatre Company, and Nunnbetter Dance. Her associate lighting designer work includes the Manhattan Theatre Club, Pearl Theatre Company, National Yiddish Theatre Folksbiene, and LCT3 as well as the Ralph Lauren and Tiffany and Co. flagship window displays. Lura-Smith earned her bachelor's at Lewis and Clark College and her MFA in design for stage and film from NYU Tisch School of the Arts.

Kimberly Manning (Costume Design)

Kimberly Manning is a New York-based costume designer and craftsperson. As resident costume designer for the Classical Theatre of Harlem (CTH), she received a 2003 Obie Award and an American Theatre Wing Design Award nomination for her costume design of CTH's production of *The Blacks: A Clown Show,* a 2005 AUDELCO Award for Melvin Van Peebles' *Ain't Supposed to Die a Natural Death,* and a 2007 American Theatre Wing Design Award for *Marat/Sade.* Manning does commission craft and design work for theater, dance, and opera.


