About Joseph Alessi

Joseph Alessi was appointed principal trombone of the New York Philharmonic in 1985 by then music director Zubin Mehta. Alessi began musical studies in his native California with his father, Joseph Alessi Sr., and continued his musical training at the Curtis Institute of Music. In 1990, he made his solo debut with the New York Philharmonic, performing Paul Creston's Fantasy for Trombone and, in 1992, premiered Christopher Rouse's Pulitzer Prize-winning Trombone Concerto with the Philharmonic. His most recent appearance with the Philharmonic as soloist was in world premiere performances of William Bolcom's Trombone Concerto in 2016. He will perform the world premiere of Chick Corea's Trombone Concerto in August. Other solo engagements have included the New Japan Philharmonic, Nagoya Philharmonic, Orchestra of Teatro Bellini, Mannheim National Theater Orchestra, Hauge Philharmonic, Helsinki Philharmonic, and the Colorado, Alabama, Santa Barbara, Syracuse, and Puerto Rico symphony orchestras. In 2002, Alessi was awarded an International Trombone Association award for his contributions to the world of trombone music and playing. He has been professor of trombone at Juilliard since 1990. He is a clinician for the Eastman-Shires Instrument Company and has recorded extensively for Naxos and Summit Records.
