Juilliard Online New Student Orientation (JONSO)

During the week of July 17, you will receive a registration notice to your Juilliard email from our online platform called Canvas. The email will come from the address Instructure Canvas <notifications@instructure.com>. Please follow the directions to access your account and to complete the JONSO by Monday, August 28 at 12:00 pm EST. JONSO is required and must be completed before you can register for classes this fall.

Complete Your Health & Immunization Record Information

The <u>Health Record Form</u> is due to Health Services by **August 1**. You will need a medical provider to complete part of the form. Any additional questions can be directed to the Health Office at (212) 799-5000 extension 282.

Fall Tuition and Room & Board Fees

Fall tuition and housing fees are due by **August 14**. Please submit your payments on time. Billing statements will be available through <u>WebAdvisor</u>.
