Financial Aid

By now, you should have reviewed your Financial Aid award letter. If you were awarded federal loan funds, you can accept or reject those funds on WebAdvisor. If you accept your loans and are a first time borrower at Juilliard, you are required to complete a Master Promissory Note and Entrance Counseling. These documents can be found online at www.studentloans.gov. Please be sure to use your own established FSA ID (the same ID you used to complete the FAFSA) to login. Juilliard Online New Student Orientation (JONSO)

All new students participating in Orientation have received an email from Canvas, our online learning platform. This email was sent to your Juilliard email address. Please follow the directions to access your account and to complete the JONSO by **Monday, August 28 at 12:00 pm EST**. Remember, JONSO is required and must be completed before you can register for classes this fall. *(You can retake the quizzes as many times as needed to complete the course.)* Click [HERE](#) to access JONSO through the Canvas login page.

Additionally, international students have been sent a second course invitation to iJONSO, specifically for designed to cover important information for studying abroad in the United

States. **International students must complete both JONSO and iJONSO.** The deadline for iJONSO is also **Monday, August 28 at 12:00 pm EST.**

Juilliard offers a comprehensive meal program for both residential and commuter students through our dining services provider, AVIFresh. The Juilliard Café, located on the plaza level of the Rose Building offers made-to-order deli sandwiches, has a full salad bar, grill station, and comfort food options in addition to grab-and-go items and a coffee bar.

New students will be the first people to visit our brand new coffee bar located in the Morse Student Lounge to get a sandwich on-the-go or get a caffeine burst between rehearsals.

All residential students must be on a meal plan, which will be announced prior to the beginning of move-in. Commuter students can purchase meal points on a declining balance that can be used at both locations.
