## Best Practices to Utilize an Off-Campus Living Agreement

- 1. It is always best to fill out an agreement with your roommates or house-mates at the beginning of living together. (Do not wait until you have a disagreement).
- 2. It is important that you think about the topics listed below before you sit down with your roommate. This will ensure that you do not feel pressure to answer the questions in any particular way.
- 3. This can be a working document. For many people, this is their first time living in an apartment with others. Make a plan to revisit this document about every two months.
- 4. Do not limit yourselves to only discuss the topics listed below. There are plenty of things that might be important for you to discuss and this document is only a touchpoint to start the conversation.
- 5. The most important topic in this document is the Feedback section. It is important that you talk about how to give feedback because it is inevitable that disagreements will occur and you will need to give feedback at some point.
- 6. Hang the agreement in a place where it can be seen by everyone in the apartment. This way, it can be a constant reminder of the boundaries that you all share.
- 7. You are welcome to hand this document in at the Office of Student Affairs and we will keep it on file for one year. (Scan to OSA@Juilliard.edu)
